



## Network Manager, Youth Mental Health Position Description

### **Position Summary**

The Network Manager provides facilitative leadership, project management, and other strategic supports to the St. Clair County Youth Coalition, equipping individuals and organizations with tools and resources to achieve shared goals toward improving the coordination, quality, and impact of mental health services and supports for young people throughout the county. The Network Manager also helps build, manage, and evaluate partnerships between area school districts and community-based youth-serving agencies.

### **Network Operations**

The Network Manager builds a strong infrastructure of supports to achieve the goals of the St. Clair County Youth Coalition. Key activities include:

- Provide facilitative and administrative leadership to the Collaborative's leadership/governing bodies
- Coordinate, facilitate, and document Collaborative meetings, events, and other activities
- Develop and manage Collaborative's operating and project budgets, ranging from five to seven-figures
- Oversee grants and provide quality grant management, ensuring deliverables are met and compliance with all financial, administrative, and programmatic requirements
- In partnership with the Collaborative, develop and implement of short- and long-range programmatic plans, providing quality project management throughout each phase
- Guide and assist with implementing evaluation activities to track the Collaborative's data, progress, and impact and support the facilitation of continuous improvement activities
- Supervise assigned staff, interns, practicum students, and/or volunteers, supporting their professional development and equipping them to perform duties effectively
- Manage relationships and contract deliverables with consultants and vendors
- Identify and assist in pursuing funding opportunities to support the Collaborative's efforts
- Support communications functions, including managing the Collaborative's social media presence and producing content for marketing efforts to strengthen awareness, increase stakeholder engagement, and generate resources

### **Community Collaboration**

The Network Manager fosters collaboration and accountability among diverse stakeholders to collectively shift system conditions. Key activities include:

- Build and manage relationships with sector leaders, youth, parent/guardians, funders, policymakers, and other key stakeholders
- Foster improved communication, coordination, and collaboration among diverse stakeholders
- Assist stakeholders in applying an equity-lens to all activities, fostering data-driven decisions, and facilitating systems change approaches
- Support stakeholders in implementing strategic initiatives and projects
- Help create and facilitate opportunities for residents to engage and lead Collaborative activities
- Represent CG on relevant local and statewide committees as well as at conferences and trainings
- Other duties as assigned

### **Requisite Qualifications**

- Demonstrated commitment to racial equity, social justice, and individual and community well-being
- A systems-oriented thinker with the ability to analyze complex relationships and situations, think outside the box, act, and promote innovative approaches
- Strong facilitation and project management skills with the ability to manage complex, multifaceted projects resulting in measurable success
- Strong relationship builder with the ability to find common ground, build consensus, and strengthen collaboration among diverse stakeholders
- Excellent communication skills, both written and oral, with the ability to represent the organization externally across a wide range of stakeholders and constituencies
- Demonstrated experience supporting and/or managing teams
- Working knowledge of organizational planning, budgeting, administrative operations, and fundraising
- Demonstrated ability to analyze and compile data for planning purposes
- Strong community awareness and astuteness
- Ability to successfully navigate in a fast-paced, results-driven, and entrepreneurial environment
